With Garmon Continental the García family completes their particular trilogy of wines and wineries in the Douro Valley -Mauro (Tudela de Duero) and San Román (Toro) - with an exciting and exclusive family project based on the vineyard, with Tempranillo or Tinto Fino as the main protagonist. Strictly limited production, never to exceed 6,600 cases per annum.

“2022 was not an easy year, a demanding vintage in terms of viticulture, and the 2022 Garmón was vinified with a softer extraction, given the natural concentration of the year. It's quite primary, with a purple color denoting youth, and it's elegant and juicy, with abundant, slightly dusty tannins. It has 7% Cabernet Sauvignon and achieved 14.5% alcohol. It was bottled after 22 months in French oak barrels. 50,000 bottles produced. It was bottled in August 2024.”
